## CIS 284: Internship

This course is designed to provide the student with an opportunity to work in a degree/program related environment. Emphasis is placed on the student's "real world" work experience as it integrates academics with practical applications that can relate meaningfully to careers in the computer discipline. Grades for this course will be based on a combination of the employer's evaluation of the student, and the contents of a report submitted by the student.
