FLT 211: Professional Pilot Helicopter Lab 3 (pvt)

In addition, the student will learn how to conduct night operations safely. Upon completion, students will demonstrate through flight tests and successfully accumulated flight experience that they meet or exceed Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) practical test standards for satisfactory completion of lessons 22 through 25 of the FAA approved Private Pilot Helicopter syllabus.
