## Tuition for Out-of-State Students and International Students

All full-time and part-time community, junior, and technical college students who are not residents of the State of Alabama shall be required to pay 2 times the rate of stated tuition. All other fees are the same.

The following individuals shall be charged the in-state/in-district rate, or otherwise considered a resident, for tuition purposes:

- A Veteran using educational assistance under either chapter Montgomery G.I. Bill<sup>®</sup> Active Duty Program) or chapter 33 (Post-9/11 G.I. Bill<sup>®</sup>), of title 38, United States Code, who lives in Alabama while attending a school located in Alabama (regardless of his/her formal State of resident) and enrolls in the school within three years of discharge or release from a period of active duty service of 90 days or more.
- Anyone using transferred Post-9/11 G.I. Bill<sup>®</sup> benefits (38 U.S.C. §3319 who lives in Alabama while attending a school located in Alabama (regardless of his/her formal State of residence) and enrolls in the school within three years of the transferor's discharge or release from a period of active duty service of 90 days or more.
- Anyone described above while he or she remains continuously enrolled (other than during regularly scheduled breaks between courses, semesters, or terms) at the same school. The person so described must have enrolled in the school prior to the expiration of the three year period following discharge or release as described above and must be using educational benefits under either chapter 30 or chapter 33, or title 38, United State Code.
- Anyone using benefits under the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship (38 U.S.C. § 3311 (b) (9)) who lives in Alabama while attending a school located in Alabama (regardless of his/her formal State of residence).
- Anyone using transferred Post-9/11 G.I. Bill<sup>®</sup> benefits (38 U.S.C. § 3319) who lives in Alabama while attending a school located in Alabama (regardless of his/her formal state of residence) and the transferor is a member of the uniformed service who is serving on active duty.
- The Policy shall be read to be amended as necessary to be compliant with the requirements of 38 U.S.C 3679 as amended.
- Anyone using the Alabama G.I. Dependent Scholarship, who, while attending, is living outside the state of Alabama.
